

Notice of the Annual City of Melrose Voter Inactivation

If you don't respond to the Annual Street Listing, you will be put on the inactive voter list.

According to Massachusetts General Law Chapter 51 section 37, the Election office will be doing an inactivation of any voters that did not return their 2023 Census. If we did not receive your signed Census, your voter registration is changed to inactive.

If you are on the inactive voter list, it does Not mean that you are no longer registered to vote. You can still vote, but you must prove that you still live in the City of Melrose by bringing identification, such as a license or a utility bill to your polling place. This allows you to cast your ballot and you will be added to the active voter list.
