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**Melrose Board of Health Rules and Regulations Concerning
Standard Requirements for the Siting, Construction, Inspection, Upgrade and Expansion of
On-Site Sewage Treatment and Disposal Systems and for the Transport and Disposal of Septage**

I. Authority

These regulations are promulgated under the authority granted to the Board of Health under Massachusetts General Law 111, section 31.

II. Minimum Standards and Administration

310 CMR 15.000 Standard Requirements for the Siting, Construction, Inspection, Upgrade and Expansion of On-Site Sewage Treatment and Disposal Systems and for the Transport and Disposal of Septage is hereby adopted in its entirety in its current form.

310 CMR 15.025: Enforcement by Approving Authorities

(2) Local approving authorities may enforce the provisions of 310. CMR 15.000 in the same manner in which local health rules and regulations are enforced.

- (a) Any person who shall violate any provision of 310. CMR 15.000 and is issued a ticket pursuant to Revised Ordinance of the City of Melrose Sections 1-21 shall be issued a ticket in the amount as noted in Section 1-21.. Each violation of each section of 310. CMR 15.000 shall constitute a separate violation. Each day's failure to comply with an order shall constitute a separate violation.

III. Severability

If any paragraph or provision of this regulation is found to be illegal or against public policy or unconstitutional, it shall not affect the legality of any remaining paragraphs or provisions being in force.

IV. Effective date

These regulations shall be effective as of June 1, 2019
