# MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT LOCAL 1617, INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS, AFL-CIO AND

## CITY OF MELROSE SUCCESSOR CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS

On September 22, 2021, Local 1617, International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO (the "Union") and the City of Melrose (the "City"), hereinafter collectively referred to as the Parties, reached a tentative agreement for a successor collective bargaining agreement for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2023, subject to ratification by the Union and funding of the economic items by the City Council. Except as expressly provided below, the Parties agree that the terms and provisions of their collective bargaining agreement ("CBA") effective July 3, 2017, to June 30, 2020, including all side letters of agreement, shall be extended without modification for the period commencing on July 1, 2020, and ending on June 30, 2023.

# 1. Cost of Living Adjustment

Article 10 of the CBA shall be amended to include the following across-the-board wage increases for all unit members of Unit A and Unit B effective retroactively to the dates indicated:

7/1/2020 7/1/2021 7/1/2022	2 % across-the-board wage increase
	2 % across-the-board wage increase
	2 % across-the-board wage increase

### 2. Mid-Career Steps

Article 10 of the CBA shall be amended to include the following new sub-section (e):

#### (e) Mid-Career Steps

Effective July 1, 2021, bargaining unit employees shall be entitled to mid-career step increases as follows:

10 years – 2% 15 years – 2% 20 years – 2%

Such mid-career step increases shall be calculated based on an employee's years of service in the Department.



### 3. Overtime

Article 8 of the CBA shall be amended to add the following new section 6.

**Section 6.** If a member of the bargaining unit uses sick leave, he or she would not be entitled to work overtime until returning to work one regularly scheduled shift, except to avoid a holdover situation.

## 4. Sick Leave

Article 23 of the CBA shall be amended by inserting new Section 1(d) as follows:

(d) Any member of the bargaining unit who leaves his or her regularly assigned shift early for personal illness or family related illness or emergency shall be charged a sick day from the member's sick leave accruals.
