- **1. Unicare is changing its name to Wellpoint.** Doctors, hospitals, and plan design remain the same.
- 2. Please note the **new contribution split (83/17)** for active employees.

What to do?



- □ Current GIC participants: register with the GIC Benefit Portal. New enrollees use myGIClink to request and submit enrollment/change forms.
- □ Be a Savvy Health Care Consumer
 - Review the 2024-2025 Benefit Decision Guide for health insurance options effective 07/01/24.
 - Consider less expensive plans with narrower networks: Wellpoint Comm. Choice, HPHC Quality.
 - Use your plan's TELEHEALTH benefit for non-urgent medical care at a low copay.
 - Take advantage of the Employee Assistance Program (Mass4You) through OPTUM for mental health counseling, work/life stressors, non-medical issues, financial and legal counseling.
- ☐ Know Tier Ratings for Your Doctors, Hospitals & Medicines
 - Tiers for doctors and hospitals may have changed in FY25. Know yours.
 - Contact your Plan about Tier 1("excellent") and Tier 2 ("good") alternatives for PCPs and Specialists. Plan contact information can be found in the GIC Decision Guide.
- ☐ Verify Provider/Hospital Network Participation Every Year
 - Call your plan or visit their website to ensure that your providers are in your plan's network!
 - Plan selections are binding for a year, unless you experience a *qualifying event*. If a doctor or hospital leaves the plan's network, the member remains in that plan. The plan will help you find a new provider.
