As a reminder, the MBTA's contractor for the Lynn Fells Parkway Bridge Replacement will close Lynn Fells Parkway beneath the bridge to safely install bridge foundations. This work will take place from 8:00 PM on Friday, August 13, through 5:00 AM on Monday, August 16.

A signed detour route will be in place for this work, and a <u>detour map</u> can be viewed on the project website. The Lynn Fells Parkway closure will begin at **8:00 PM on Friday, August 13**. We encourage drivers to avoid the area or seek alternate routes to avoid delays.

Commuter Rail service on the Haverhill Line will be suspended after 10:00 PM on Friday, August 13, through 5:00 AM on Monday, August 16. Alternate bus transportation will be provided. Visit the <u>MBTA</u> alerts page for up-to-date information.
