I. New Business:

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 4 of Chapter 76 of the Massachusetts Acts of 1998, the Melrose Traffic Commission holds this Public Hearing on rules, regulations, and votes adopted by the Melrose Traffic Commission at its October 28, 2021 pertaining to the following as identified in the petition submitted to the City signed by more than 25 registered voters of the City of Melrose on November 15, 2021:

- 1. Changing parking on the west side of Main Street (southbound) from about 244 Main street continuing south to Sylvan Street
- 2. Adding dedicated bike lanes on the east side of Main Street (northbound) from 338 feet north of the Melrose/Malden City limit to Mount Vernon Street
- 3. Adding dedicated bike lanes on Main Street southbound (west side) from about 244 Main Street to Sylvan Street
- 4. Amending the Melrose Traffic Code for consistency with existing signage on Main Street, both sides, south of Wyoming Avenue to the Melrose/Malden City limit as it pertains to parking restrictions and time limits.
