NOTICE FOR INFILTRATION TRENCHES PROJECT

October 17, 2023

1 Clover Circle (on Maple Street)

The City has received a Coastal Zone Management grant from the Executive Office of Environmental Affairs to install infiltration trenches in various locations around the City. The infiltration trenches will be connected to an existing catch basin and capture the first flush to infiltrate the stormwater runoff. These infiltration trenches consist of underground perforated pipe in stone. The trench will then be paved (or loam and seeded as applicable) at the surface. This will target pollutants such as phosphorus to help improve water quality in our waterways (Ell Pond and Mystic River).

You are receiving this notice because a location was identified near your property. The infiltration trench will begin at the catch basin located on the southwest corner of side Maple Street at Clover Circle, and will extend west along Maple Street for a total length of approximately 100 feet.

Construction will begin on Wednesday October 18th and should be complete by end of day Thursday October 19th. There will be no disruption to your utilities but there will be a minor traffic impact in the area due to the work area being closed off.
