PLANTING NOTES

1. All plant material shall conform to the guidelines established by B&B Lg. Tre "The American Standard for Nursery Stock", published by the American B&B Sm. Tre Hort. B&B 2. Any proposed substitutions of plant species shall be a plant of B&B equivalent overall form, height and branching habit, flower, leaf and fruit, color and time of bloom. pots pots 3. The Contractor shall locate and verify all utility line locations prior pots to excavation for tree pits and report any conflicts to the Landscape Archipots tect. pots pots 4. The rootballs of trees shall be planted 3" above adjacent finished pots grade. The rootballs of shrubs shall be planted 2" above adjacent finpots ished grade. The rootflare of perennials shall be set at the level at which pots the plant was growing. pots pots 5. All planting to be done under the full time supervision of a certified pots arborist, nurseryman or licensed Landscape Architect. pots pots 6. All plants are to be thoroughly watered after installation, at least pots twice within the first 24 hours.
